Dearness Relief: the consumer price index for July to December 2015 has shown rise resulting in 62 slab D. R increase in the pensioner effective from February 16 payable in march16. It is a matter of concern for all if the inflation is going up in this manner. An extract of Govt notification is given below for information:-

Consumer Price Index for Industrial Workers (CPI-IW) – November, 2015

The maximum upward pressure to the change in current index came from Food group contributing (+) 0.64 percentage points to the total change. At item level, Wheat, Urd Dal, Mustard Oil, Eggs (Hen), Milk, Chillies-Dry, Garlic, Carrot, Lady's Finger, Peas, Potato, Tomato, Tea (Readymade), Sugar, Flower/Flower Garlands, Tailoring Charges, etc. are responsible for the increase in index. However, this increase was restricted by Chillies Green, Onion, Brinjal, Cauliflower, Green Coriander Leaves, Methi, Radish, etc., putting downward pressure on the index. ”

Life certificate: pensioners are senior citizens, some find it difficult to move out some are immobile whereas some are out of station during the days of submitting life (existing) certificate. due to non submission of certificate many do not receive pension on time. They are made to run here & there adding to their difficulties. United India initiated submitting life certificate online by visiting any nearby office with I D card this year. This sudden change without intimation worried the pensioner. Our Federation met Shri Milind Kahrat in Mumbai on 5th January 2016 & pointed out difficulties faced especially those immobile pensioners & family pensioners residing in remote places. On 11th January we have sent a letter also confirming discussion. Now that digital life certificate is being introduced all of us must be ready to equip ourselves. In **brief** it will be “ **Jeevan Pramaan- A Hit With Pensioners**

In Jeevan Pramaan a pensioner can digitally show that he or she is alive using his/her biometrics. Biometric devices are available in CSC's, Bank branches, Pensioner associations, Govt. offices etc. More over any citizen can also purchase a finger print scanner and do the identification from home. A typical finger print scanner currently costs around Rs. 2600/- only and the prices are expected to come down in future. The usefulness of Jeevan Pramaan will increase even further as the biometric authentication device gets integrated with mobile phones.

All pension disbursing organizations, which have a requirement of periodic life certificate to continue disbursing pension are welcome to join this free offering. ”

Mediclaim: By our letter dt 24 January 2015 we requested & insisted as:

“ We therefore request GIPSA to:- a) amend staff GMP allowing reimbursements of expenses of diagnostic test without hospitalization, b) coverage of fully depended disable children of retirees, c) provide one more option to join the Scheme, d) provide claim experience for the period 01/02/2014 to 31/01/2015 and e) ensure that there is no break in continuity of GMP of retired employees. ”

GIPSA has conceded a) one more (last) option to join the staff mediclaim scheme before 31st March 2016, b) differently able family members are allowed cover under staff GMP for all time, C) correction of premium chart for the age band 71-75 years which was pushed to next band of 76 years & above.

We urge all pensioners/retirees to avail this last option to join the staff GMP. Inform others. We

also feel that independent children who are allowed to join the scheme should join. Please remit the required premium before 31st March 2016 without fail.

Reimbursement of diagnostic test without hospitalisation as is prevailing in LIC is yet not conceded.

Issue of Identity Card: the Retired Employees and family Pensioners/Spouse/First eligible members of the pensioner suffer for want of identification when they visit offices for any purpose. The plight of family pensioners are worst as no one knows them and do not identify. We have been requesting GIPSA to issue fresh I D cards including Nominee of the pensioners at the time of retiring. This is being pursued further.

Court cases:- Alhabad court case: Court No. - 36 Case :- WRIT - A No. - 24580 of 2007 Petitioner :- Jagdish Narain Khanna And Others Respondent :- Union Of India And Others **The parties' counsel agree that Civil Appeal Nos. 29956-29957 of 2011, LIC versus Krishna Murari Lal Asthana on the point in issue in this writ petition are pending before the Apex Court. It is submitted by the parties that it would be appropriate for this Court to hear this writ petition after the decision rendered by the Apex Court in the aforesaid appeals. The office is directed to list this writ petition after receipt of the judgment of the Apex Court in the aforesaid appeals. Order Date :- 11.7.2014.**

The said case in S. C. is yet not decided & now fixed on 10th March 2016.

Updation of pension:- W. P. 7188 in HC & WP 629/2015 of S C by Aam Bima on the same ground. This matter is in stalemate.

W. P. 328/2010 Bombay H. C. filed by this Association is yet to come up for hearing KaSeva Nivirtta Karmachari Samiti Jodhpur: the earlier order of Raj H C to Ministry has been negated by Ministry. Therefore W. P. in C has filed & got dismissed because of S C denial in SVRS case. An appeal to S C also was not admitted.

5 years credit to SVRS class II pensioners: Hon'ble Ms. Justice Nirmaljeet Kaur of Rajasthan High Court, Jodhpur issued notice for final disposal to NIC, NIA, OIC and UIIC today in Writ Petition No. 114 / 2015 by Aam Beema Seva Nivirtta Karmachari Samiti, Jodhpur filed by Anil Bhandari for granting 5 years notional benefit under para 30(5) of pension scheme in respect of to Class II who took VRS under the 2003 scheme. C W Petition filed by AamBima sevanivirtta Karmachari Samiti for benefits of increase of notional 5 years service to development staff who took SVRS under 2003 scheme was argued for two hours by Adv. Anil Bhandari on 3rd February 2016 before Hon miss Jaishree Thakur of Rajasthan H C, Jodhpur. Further hearing is scheduled to take place next week.

RBI : However, the arm-twisting tactics of bureaucrats of Ministry of Finance (MoF) has forced the heads of corporate bodies like RBI, LIC not to observe the Article 14 and SC verdicts in the matter of revision/updation of pension and deny just updation of pension to retirees. We RBI pensioners and family pensioners are victims on account of this big hunting game of MoF. We could only know the Bank's attempt vide DO th letter dated 11 Oct. 2011 to MoF. The said letter, obtained.

Wage Revision:- it is heartening to note that in service employees could get average 15% increase in the wages which will also benefit them on retirement. Wage structure is better than Banking industry and against few odds.

However the pensioner/retiree after August 2012 did not get their arrears as on with the in-service employees in spite of repeated request to GIPSA Companies. We are pained to witness such an attitude with the pensioners who worked all along but on retirement got slightly different treatment. Similarly those who have retired earlier but have contributed for the progress of GIPSA companies have not at all considered in this wage revision by management & Government.
